**TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. Tenderer has to submit the photocopy of license for commercial pest control operation at the time of submission of tender. Tender form will not be considered in absence of license.
2. Tenderer has to submit License under the contract Labour ( R&A) Act 1970.(IF applicable)
3. Tenderer has to submit registration Certificate of GST, P.F reg. no. ESI No.(IF applicable)
4. No minor labour is allowed to work at the plant. If any minor labour found in pest control work then contractor will be held responsible .
5. The contractor will deposit an amount of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five Thousand only) & EMD amount Rs. 10000/- will be adjusted towards security total Rs. 35000/- with the Sangh. The said amount shall be refunded to the contractor after proper execution of work / completing contract otherwise the amount will be forfeited by Sangh.
6. The Sangh reserve the right to add or alter any condition at any moment. It will be binding on the contractor, provided that the change does not adversely affect the contractor in terms of finance etc.
7. The contractor shall have to abide by all the rules and regulation of Sangh formulated time to time.
8. The period of contract will be one year from the date of work order and can be extended for another six month on mutual consent.
9. Managing Director, Sangh can terminate the contract at any time without assigning any reason.
10. Any person related to Sangh and its Cooperative Societies in any manner cannot take part in the tender.
11. Whole & final right of rejection/acceptance of tender lies with Managing Director of Sangh without assigning any reason.
12. Successful tenderer will have to be become a nominal member of Sangh after deposing Rs. 100/- as a nominal membership fees.
13. Before assuming work an agreement shall be executed by contactor on rupees 500 \- nonjudicial stamp paper with Sangh .
14. All issues and matters shall be within the jurisdiction of Hanumangarh Junction.

## Specific Terms and Conditions of the contract for Pest Control

### 1. SCOPE OF SERVICE

General Disinfection for eradication of mosquitoes, flying insects such as and including flies, cockroaches, red and black ants, spiders, mites, silverfish, lizard, rodents such as rats etc. or any other plant or animal life not useful to human beings. The pest control activities shall be carried out in the Production and Processing area, office & storage premises, compound premises, Vehicles etc. under the provisions of insecticides act 1968 and Central Insecticides Rules 1971 there under. The chemicals, concentrations and their usage should be subjected to the insecticides act 1968. The details of premises are briefly described in Annexure

The scope of work includes spraying of pesticide at all places and buildings, applying of chemicals as per prescribed dosages as residual/ Non residual insecticides spray under supervision of technically qualified and accredited pest control.

### 2. FREQUENCY OF THE SERVICE:

Complete prevention from all crawling & flying insects. The details are given below and the service frequency is also mentioned.

3. Office, Production and Processing area, store premises and any other premises inside the campus shall be treated inside along with a placement of gum board. Gum boards shall be kept inside to avoid misuse and spillage of the product. For rodent control, metal traps (with the placement of bait) should be placed both within and in the compound premises (wherever permitted by Sangh). The metal traps, wherever placed, should be checked on a fortnightly basis.

4. General disinfections should also be carried out for the common portion of the building premises including drains, floor lobbies and steps of the building.

5. The control measure must be effective against pests like mosquitoes, flying insects such as and including flies, cockroaches, red and black ants, spiders, mites, silverfish, rodents such as rats etc. The chemical used must have residual action to take care of any recurrence of infestation. While spraying, special attention must be given to hiding places such as undersides of the furniture, behind doors, windows etc.

6. No chemical should be sprayed in food handling areas. During the Production and Processing, pest control action will not be allowed. All pesticides applied inside the Production and Processing area, food storage and any other food handling areas should be non-toxic and safe; it should not result in contamination of any of the food items at Sangh locations either directly or indirectly.

7. Contractor will provide check list with detail plan of action for disinfections with prior intimation to Sangh or to appointed Quality In-charge or authorized person of Sangh. MSDS (Material Safety Data Sheet) for chemicals should be submitted to Sangh. Any special precaution to be taken by Sangh, before/during/after the services should be communicated to Sangh immediately without fail by contractor. Evaluation and trend analysis for all pests must be submitted to Sangh monthly.

8. All the household pest such as mosquitoes, house flies, cockroaches, rats, spiders, ants etc. will be controlled /managed by CIB registered, WHO approved for use in public health and ISI marked chemicals in an eco-friendly and integrated manner. All the chemicals will be strictly applied in as per prescribed dosages as residual/ Non residual insecticides spray under supervision of technically qualified and accredited pest control.

9. Details of chemicals with concentration used by the pest control agency must be submitted to the Quality In-charge of Sri ganganagar zila dugdh utpadak sahkari Sangh Ltd., before applying the same in Production and Processing premises. All pesticides should be kept in original containers with label.

10. The chemicals/pest control materials used by contractor should not have any adverse effect on human life. It should not leave any stains or marks on the areas where the service is provided.

The chemicals and pest control material should not leave deposits on food ingredients, food materials, processed milk and milk products and any equipment, machinery of asset that is used in handling of food. Loss of any kind with result of improper pest control services shall be born by contractor.

**11. APPROVED CHEMICALS AND CERTIFICATE:**

Contractor should submit approval certificates issued by Central Insecticides Board for the chemicals being used after awarding the contract. The chemical/pesticide used shall be of reputed manufacturer and for its effectiveness and safety to human beings in a environment. Contractor has to submit the list of chemicals and materials safety data sheet before starting the work and has to keep the Antidotes in Laboratory.

**12. STATUTORY LEVIES:**

The Contractor will pay all statutory liabilities of the workers and employees engaged by him and ensure that they are paid minimum wages as notified by State Government from time to time and all other statutory liabilities shall be complied with by the contractor.

The Contractor shall wherever applicable comply with the provisions of the Payment of Wages Act 1936, Minimum Wages Act 1948, Employees Provident Fund & Miscellaneous Provision Act 1952, ESI Act 1948, Employer's Liability Act 1930, Workmen's Compensation Act 1923, Industrial Dispute Act 1947 and Contract Labour (Regulations and Abolition) Act, 1970 or the modifications thereof or any other laws relating thereto and the rules made there under from time to time.

All the persons deployed by Service Provider/Contractor will exclusively work under his supervision & control. These persons shall be exclusively Service Provider's employees.

Contractor will be solely responsible for any claim, damage, compensation etc. that may become payable to any of the person(s) deployed by you in connection with this work. In event of an accident or mishap resulting in any disability, injury or death of the person of yours in connection with or concerning the said work within or outside the premises of the Sangh. Sangh shall not be liable in any manner whatsoever either monetarily or otherwise for any accident or mishap as mentioned above.

Contractor have to comply with all statutory and administrative requirements in connection with (i) personnel so deployed by you in connection to the said work (ii) their commercial arrangement.

Indemnity the Sangh against any payment to be made under and for the observance of the above-mentioned various laws & rules.

**13. WARRANTY REQUIRED:**

For Production and Processing and store premises we desire gel based technology for the control of cockroaches. Any interim complaint of non-effectiveness of recent treatment done should be attended to free of cost. A treatment report should be submitted on monthly basis detailing any preventive/corrective measures to be under taken.

**14. KYC OF THE EMPLOYEES:**

The contractor should submit to Sangh office, all KYC details of the trained supervisors/workers/employees who will be working on the Sangh premises along with their qualifications and experience, within 15 days of the commencement of the contract.

In case of any change of staff details about the new staff shall be immediately made available to Sangh.

The Sangh shall have the right from time to time to demand any original record and/or photo state copies of such record either for inspection and/or for retention for any duration in connection with or concerning (i) the said work of the Sangh (ii) the persons engaged by you for the said work (iii) payment made/ to be made Provident Fund contribution, ESI contribution, Gratuity, etc. you shall make available all documents so demanded by the Sangh.

It is expressly agreed that the persons so deployed for above said work at our premises shall not any time be or demand to be the employees of the Sangh. All wages and allied benefits such as leaves, ESI, Provident Fund, Gratuity, Bonus etc. shall be paid by you and the Sangh shall not incur any liability whatsoever monetary or otherwise or pay more than agreed fixed amount for said work.

None of the staff of the contractor shall be liable to claim any sort of employment with Sangh.

The Contractor shall ensure that the workmen employed are medically fit and in sound mind and health.

#### **15. TIMINGS:**

Normal working hours for trained operator will be 8 hours a day or 48 hours a Week and extra leave will be deductible from the monthly bill. Treatment can be carried out in shift with an advance prior intimation and a telephonic confirmation at least 24 hours before commencing the job.

**16.** The contractor will have to organize adequate work force and supervisors etc. who shall be solely responsible for all the operation and maintenance as indicated in scope of work.

The pest control operator must be trained to determine the best pesticide for each pest and how and where to apply it.

The Contractors shall pay wages to Labour employed by him directly. As and when, any extra works is to be carried out, the contractor shall do the job without any extra cost to Sangh.

**17.** The contractor agency shall arrange for all the material required for pest control activities on its own and shall not store any of the materials/ chemicals in Sangh Production and Processing area and same can store under lock and key facility at designated place outside Production and Processing area.

All tools and tackles for routine maintenance shall be arranged by the contractor.

**18.** Contractor should maintain the report of opening and closing of locker or designated store provided by Sangh and same report should be submitted monthly basis to Quality in charge .

19. The contractor shall make arrangement to issue identity cards to each of the workmen for entry in to the premises. The identity cards shall be issued by the contractor at his own cost in collaboration with the security agency. Security staff shall be at liberty to exercise check on any of the workers, while entering, search them in the premises during the work and while leaving the premise.

20. In case of any accident/damage etc. caused due to the negligence of the staff deployed by the contractor, the loss shall have to be made good by the contractor and no claim will be entertained by Sangh. The loss or damage shall be ascertained by the Sangh and the decision of the MD Sangh shall be final & binding to you.

21. The entire work shall have to be carried out in complete coordination with the security and other working agencies. Any damages to the equipments belonging to the SANGH shall have to be made good by the contractor at his own cost.

22. The staff to be deployed at site should be competent, experienced and qualified in the trade. The list of such staff shall be got approved by the Sangh. The decision of the Sangh shall be final in this regard. Any change in the staff once deployed shall be allowed only with the prior approval of the Sangh. The contractor shall be responsible for the statutory requirement in case of skilled staff deployed at site.

23. The contractor shall be bound to maintain service records, complaints received and attended by his staff. The Staff will be under the control and supervision of the Contractor including their performance and discipline.

24. The contractor will submit bill with documentary proof for salary paid to their staff.

25. The Contractor shall not sub-contract the whole or any part of this contract to another person/third party.

## 26. UNSATISFACTORY PERFORMANCE

If the performance of the contractor is not satisfactory and he fails to attend the complaints in time as stipulated in the contract, fails to attend the complaint to any of the works as contained in the scope of work, recovery from his bills will be made.

The decision of the Sangh in respect of the magnitude of non-performance and its recovery thereof shall be binding on the contractor.

The contractor shall be responsible for the acts and deeds of its staff. Sangh will in no way be responsible for violation of any applicable law, rules and / or other loss caused either by the contractor or by its staff.

Any recurrence of pests at any point of time, after the service is not acceptable and Pest Control Services, should take corrective action immediately at no extra cost to Sangh

Sangh reserves its right to recover from periodical payments to be made to the Contractor, any loss or damage that may be caused to the equipment, machinery, building or any other property of Sangh by negligence or any other reason whatsoever by the Contractor.

In case any worker of the contractor is found drinking milk, stealing milk pouches/ material etc. a penalty up to 20(Twenty) times of the cost of product will be imposed on the contractor besides other disciplinary action against the defaulter may be taken by the Sangh.

In case of unsatisfactory Pest Control Services, a penalty upto Rs. 5000/- may be imposed and contract can also be terminated.

## **27. COMPLIANCE OF SECURITY REQUIREMENTS:**

The contractor will ensure that its staff must have Security Passes / Identity Card to enter the premises of the Sangh to attend the duties. The staff should be polite and courteous.

The contractor will ensure that his staff should not be under the influence of liquor while on duty and any damage to the Sangh property will be borne by the contractor.

## **28. PAYMENT TERMS:**

The payment will be made after deducting the TDS and other eligible taxes. If any tax imposed by government in future, will be liability of contractor. The contract amount shall be inclusive of all taxes, levies etc. as per its applicability. The contractor shall indicate percentage and amount of GST in their bill separately.

## **29. INSURANCE**

Insurance under Workmen's Compensation Act and other Liabilities: Workmen's Compensation Policy for your employed person to be submitted within 15 days of Letter of Award or handing over of Site whichever is earlier.

In the event of there being, any increase of workmen's compensation, insurance Premium under any law or any additional or new liability under the labour laws being imposed on the contractor shall be borne by him and no claim shall be entertained by Sangh on any account.

## **30. OVERPAYMENTS & UNDERPAYMENT**

Whenever any claim for the payment of a sum of money to Sangh arises out of or under this contract against the Contractor, either he shall pay the claim on demand or the same may be deducted by Sangh from any sum due to which at any time thereafter may become due to the Contractor under this Contract and failing that under any other

## **31. CANCELLATION / TERMINATION OF CONTRACT**

If the contractor at any time makes default in proceeding with the work with the due negligence and continues to do so after notice in writing of 7 days from Sangh or Commits defaults in complying with any of the terms and condition of the contract and does not remedy it or take effective steps to remedy within 7 days of notice in writing or fails to complete the items of works as stipulated and does not complete within the specified period.

Sangh shall without any prejudice or any other right of remedy which shall have accrued or shall accrue there after the Sangh can cancel the contract within a period of one month reckoned from the date of issue of the first notice.

In the event of the contractor committing, breach of any of the terms and conditions herein contained and/or required to be observed and to be performed by the contractor, for the satisfactory and faithful performance of the contract, Sangh shall be at liberty to terminate this contract by giving one month's notice and without assigning any reasons, and Sangh shall be entitled to forfeit the security deposit or any part thereof.

### **32. LAWS GOVERNING THE CONTRACT**

This contract shall be governed by the Indian Laws in force.

**33.** The contractor shall employ in, and about the execution for works, only such persons as are skilled and experienced in their trades and submit the list of workers so employed, and the Sangh shall be at liberty to object to and require the contractor to remove from the works any person employed by the contractor who in the opinion of the Sangh, misconducts or is incompetent or negligent in the proper performance of his duties and such person shall not be again employed up on the works without permission of the Sangh. Decision of the Sangh in this respect shall be final.

**34.** Performance of the contractor's work shall be reviewed by Sangh authorities time to time, wherein senior representative of the contracting firm will have to be present.

**35.** It is the contractor's duty to arrange competent persons shall be arranged to attend to on any day, including Saturdays, Sundays and other Government holidays for complaint calls. There will be no limit to such complaint calls. Complaint calls shall be attended to as and when intimated, within the least possible time, not exceeding 4 hours in any case and it is the part of contractor's scope of work.

**36.** The contractor shall pay & continue to pay during contract and also pay till full and final settlement with the labours (s) or workers for all statutory requirements applicable as per rules and applicable laws, including, gratuity/benefits pertaining, to the currency of the contract. He shall indemnify Sangh and shall keep Sangh indemnified against all such claims.

**37.** The Sangh reserve the right to add or alter any condition at any moment. It will be binding on the contractor, provided that the change does not adversely affect the contractor in terms of finance etc.

**38.** The contractor shall have to abide by all the rules and regulation of Sangh formulated time to time.

**39.** The period of contract will be one year from the date of work order and can be extended for another six month on mutual consent.

**40.** All issues and matters shall be within the jurisdiction of Hanumangarh Junction.

**41.** According to the appeal provision of RTTP Act, Managing Director, Sri Ganganagar Zila Dugdh Utpadak Sahkari Sangh Ltd., Hanumangarh will be Appellate Officer.
